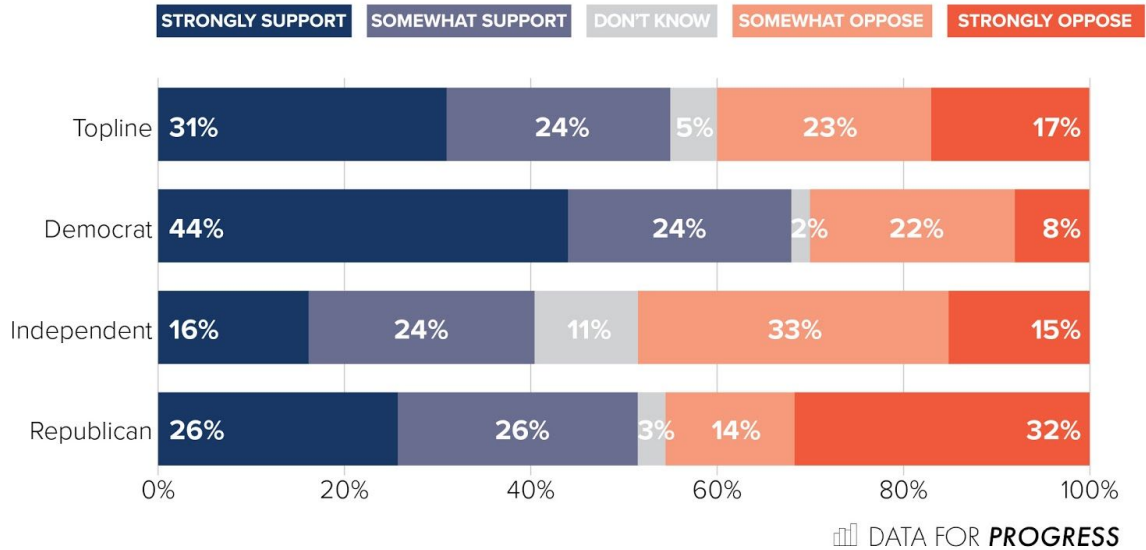


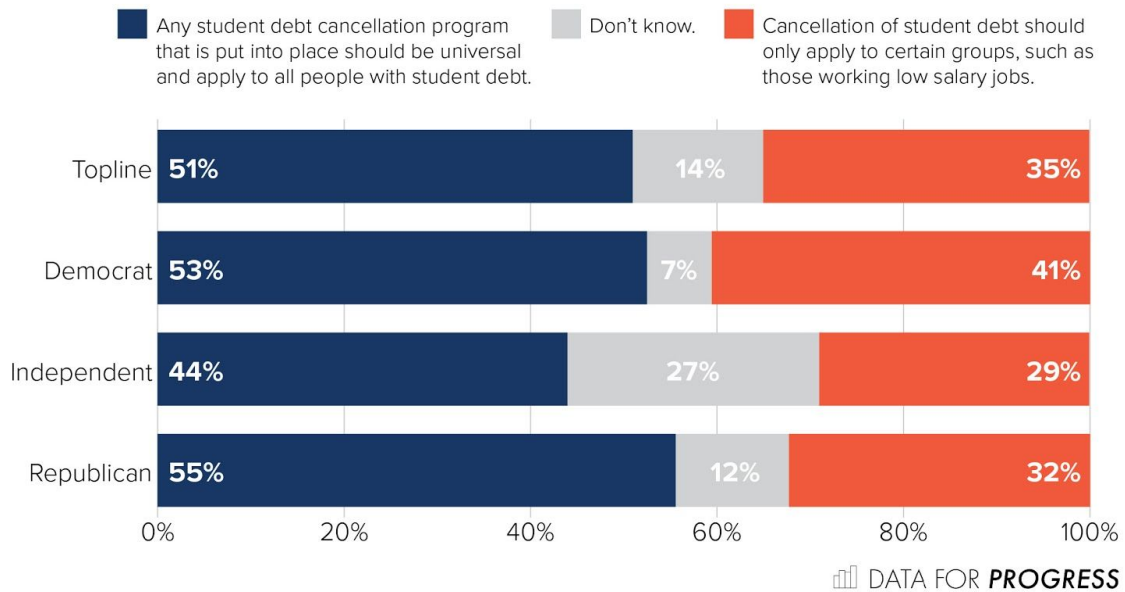

Poll Results: Voters Support Executive Action To Cancel Student Debt

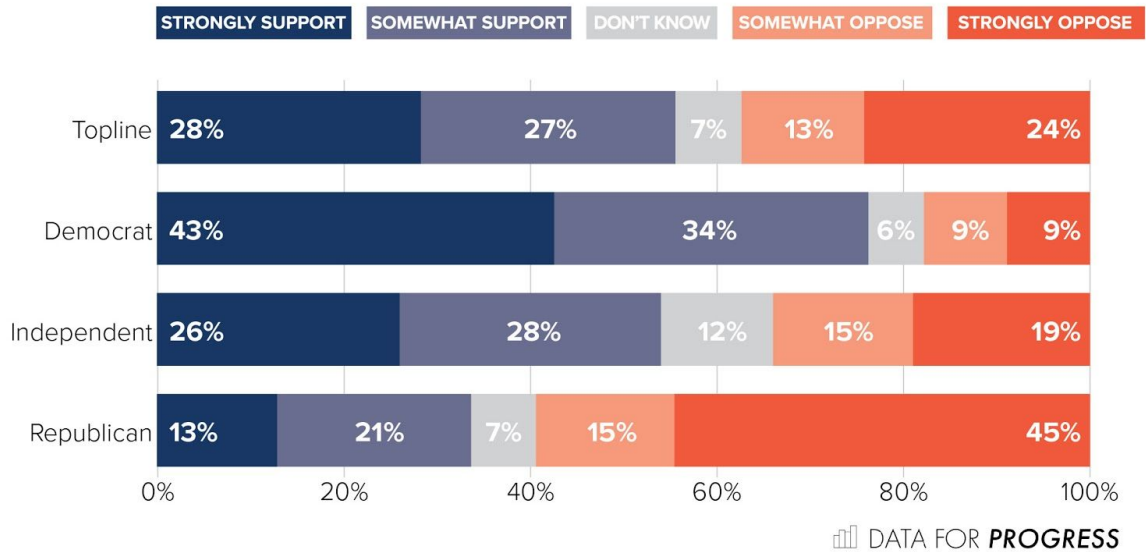
1. Do you support or oppose cancelling all student debt that people currently have?



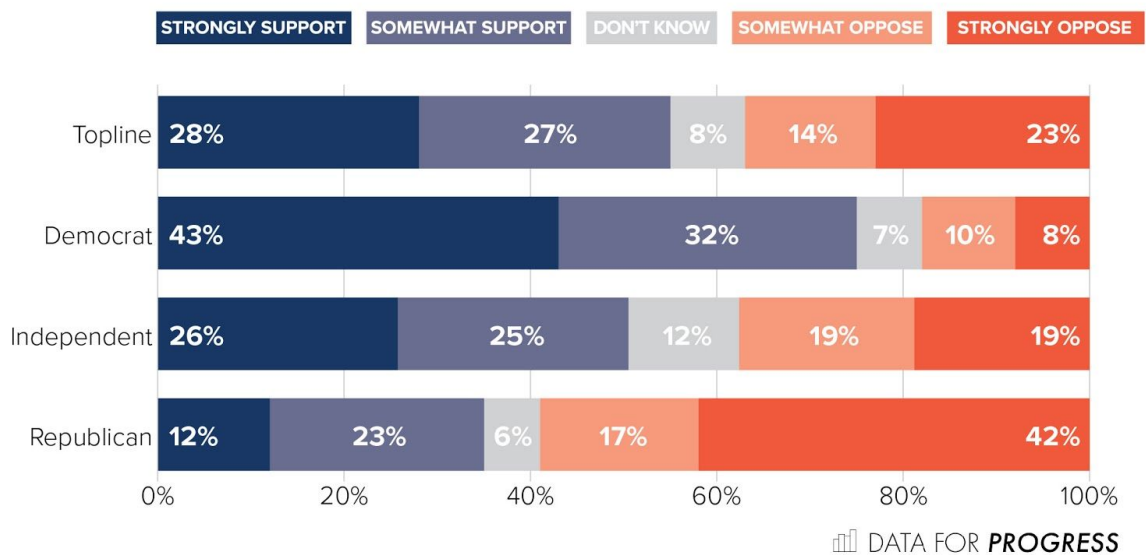
2. What comes closer to your view?



3. **President-elect Joe Biden said he plans to consider using executive action to cancel some or all of the nation's \$1.6 trillion in federal student debt. In general, would you support or oppose executive action to cancel at least some student loan debt currently owed to or guaranteed by the federal government?**



4. **Some experts advocate broad student loan debt cancellation as a means of stimulating the economy and providing income relief during the pandemic. Would you support or oppose President-elect Biden following this guidance and using executive power to cancel up to \$75,000 worth of student debt per borrower?**



Polling Methodology

Questions 1-2: Data for Progress conducted a survey from 9/18/2020 to 9/19/2020 of 1,104 likely voters nationally using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is +/- 2.9 percentage points.

Questions 3-4: Data for Progress conducted a survey from 12/4/20 to 12/6/20 of 1,080 likely voters nationally using the same methodology. The margin of error is ± 3.0 percentage points.
